Course

This 6-week beginner's class for genealogy and family history is designed to allow the student an opportunity to create a family tree and to search for genealogical records. It will be taught in a computer lab to expose students to the available technology. This is an interactive course providing education and plenty of in-class practice. Students will leave the class with a family tree, the ability to add to that tree and the knowledge of what records they need to go further. In addition, they will learn where to find those records, how to document their findings, and the reliability of various records.
